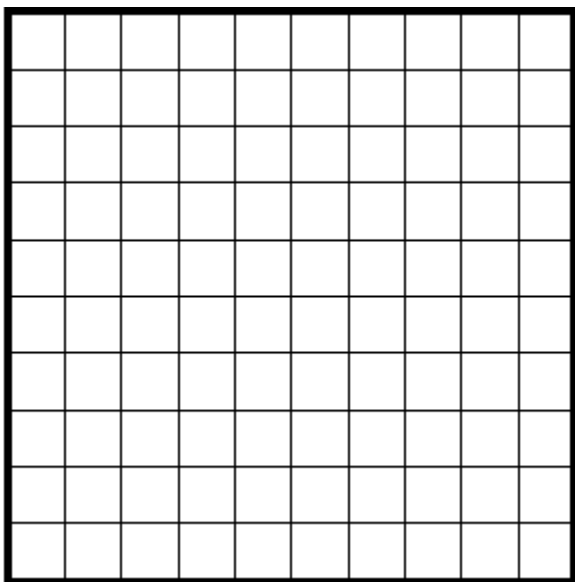


**EQ: How Can I Model Dividing Decimals by decimals?**

**Steps**

1. Shade in the dividend you will be dividing on the 100 grid below.
2. You will be circling groups of the divisor from the number of squares you shaded in on the grid.
3. The number of groups you were able circle will equal your quotient (answer).
4. Check each problem using the algorithm or another method.
5. If you are unsure what to do- or which number to use, try solving a simpler problem to help your understanding the meaning of the math vocabulary words.

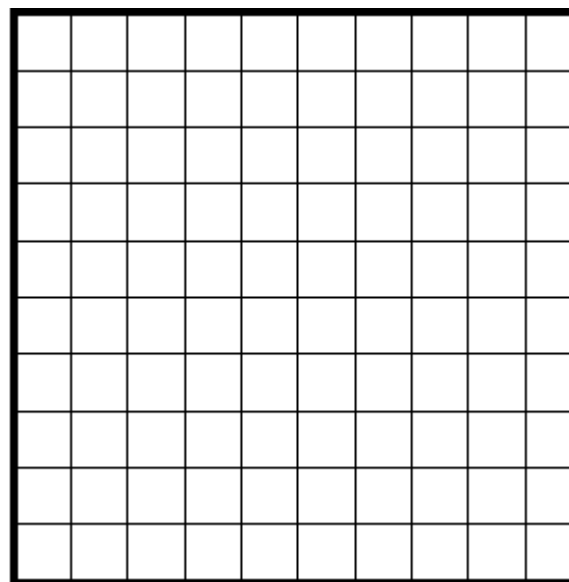
