Parent Survey: The School Climate Star Rating is a diagnostic tool to determine if a school is on the right path to school improvement. The rating is based on four components:

- 1) student, teacher, and parent perceptions of a school's climate
- 2) student discipline
- 3) a safe and substance-free learning environment and
- 4) school-wide attendance.

The Georgia Parent Survey is now open for the 2019-20 school year. This survey influences a portion of the School Climate Star Rating. The survey contains 24 questions that can be answered by using a personal computer, smart phone or tablet. Survey responses are anonymous and will be submitted directly to the Georgia Department of Education for analysis.
